Thanks for your ecoperation – with your help, we're going to make the Mundi Mundi Bash amazing!




BEFORE ARRIVING AT THE FESTIVAL


Affix vehicle stickers to passenger-side windscreen



— Affix dog friendly campsite sticker if required

Put on your wristband





GETTING TO MUNDIVILLE

• Choose the right ROLL IN TIME for your ticket type

ROLL IN 8AM - 6PM DAILY ONLY THU 15 - Roll In from 7am and join us for Big Blue Day 3 DAY Early Entry Vehicle Pass from MON 12 2 DAY Early Entry Vehicle Pass from TUE 13 1 DAY Early Entry Vehicle Pass...... from WED 14 STANDARD ENTRY.....THU 15 (from 7am) & FRI 16 (8am)

- From Broken Hill, head ~ 35km north-west on Brookfield Ave, then Silverton Rd (2WD accessible).
- No overtaking.
- When you arrive in Mundiville, follow directions from Bash road marshals.
- Expect delays of several hours at peak times.
- · At the gate, tell marshals if you are rolling in with a group of two or more vehicles.
- · GATES CLOSE 6PM SHARP.

GETTING TO YOUR CAMPSITE

- Stick to the Mundiville speed limit. 10km/h minimises dust and keeps everyone safe.
- Our marshals will direct you to GENERAL, DOG or DISABILITY camping areas.
- Campsites are filled from front to back.

DURING THE BASH

• Come prepared and plan to park up, kick back and relax for the whole Bash!

NO DRIVING IN MUNDIVILLE CAMP!

Need to leave the campground during the Bash?



There's a transfer bus to Silverton.



You can also drive out of camp Mon 12 - Fri 16 @ 4 - 6pm ONLY but you can't drive back in.



You must leave your car in DAY PARKING and walk back to camp.



Come and go from town to DAY PARKING 8am - 10pm.





Bring your car back to camp on Saturday @ 12.30 - 1.30pm.

ROLL OUT

NEED TO KNOW

- More than 60 road marshals.
- Over 6000 vehicles leaving Mundiville over 1 ½ days.
- As campers pack up they need to join the line. Make room – there's no such thing as pushing in.
- Tune in to BashFM for live traffic updates.

ROLLING OUT

EARLY EXIT Sat 17 @ 2 - 5pm

GENERAL EXIT

Sun 18 @ 6am – 6pm & Mon 19 @ 6am – Midday

HOW TO AVOID TRAFFIC

- Early exit Pass
- Leave after peak-time (after 4pm)
- Stay an extra night

DRIVING BACK TO BROKEN HILL

- Expect delays.
- Don't overtake.
- Please observe road and lookout closures, changed speed limits and police directions.

ROLL OUT TRAFFIC GUIDE

SATURDAY 17TH

PRE ROLL OUT EARLY EXIT 12.30 – 1.30pm

Return vehicle from Day Parking: Bring car back to your camp: pack & prepare for roll out. 2pm - 5pm

Early Exit Pass holders only. Minor delays capped but still significant number exiting. \$15 online or Merch tent, till sold out.

SUNDAY 18TH

6am - 4pm

PEAK

Peak time: Leaving early on Sunday you can expect wait time of several hours. Please be patient. If you're not in a hurry wait for off-peak time.

MONDAY 19th OFF-PEAK

Off peak: You might experience minor delays, but can generally expect less traffic.

4pm Sun – 12pm Mon
